One (1) Position Available. The District of Hudson's Hope is accepting applications for employment as **General Trades-Level 3** for the Hudson's Hope Public Works Department. **Grader Operator experience preferred.**

The District of Hudson's Hope invites applications from qualified persons for the full-time position of General Trades. The successful candidate will be required to operate a variety of equipment, including the grader and perform any assignments related to water supply, sewage disposal, storm drainage, roadway maintenance and construction, recreation facilities and municipal services. The work also involves the safe operation, routine inspection and maintenance of equipment and vehicles used on the job.

Preference will be given to those applicants with: grader operator experience; a valid Water Distribution or Water Treatment Level 1 Certificate; a valid Wastewater Collection or Wastewater Treatment Level 1 Certificate. Any mechanical tickets or heavy equipment operator and maintenance experience will be considered. A Class 1 or 2 driver's license with an airbrake endorsement will be required. A mechanical background with equipment on air will be considered an asset. Shift work including weekends may be required. A driver's abstract and criminal record check may be a condition of employment.

The successful candidate will be designated as General Trades 3. The job description is available upon request.
