2) To delete subsubsection f. i. and replace it with:

"District Council will consider tenders by resolution where the procurement value exceeds:

- a) \$75,000 or greater for goods;
- b) \$75,000 or greater for services; or
- c) \$200,000 or greater for construction.";

3) To delete subsection g. and replace it with:

"In other cases where the procurement value is under:

- a) 75,000 or greater for goods;
- b) \$75,000 or greater for services; or
- c) \$200,000 or greater for construction

and the recommendation is to award to the low tender, the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to award the contract and to report such decisions to Council.";

4) to delete subsection h. and replace it with:

"The District will obtain, if possible, three written quotations for procurement values under:

- a) \$75,000 for goods;
- b) \$75,000 for services; or
- c) \$200,000 for construction.
