# Water Treatment Plant Update

We are pleased to share the following updates on the Water Treatment Plant upgrades:

- All major work packages for the Water Treatment Plant upgrade have been awarded.
- Construction is progressing with:
  - Excavation and installation of new underground tanks to begin soon
  - Mechanical and electrical work continues inside the plant
  - Commissioning remains on track for summer.
- Advance notice will be provided if any boil water advisories are required during commissioning.



# GARBAGE COLLECTION

Please ensure that **ALL garbage is fully bagged and sealed before placing it in your bin.** Loose garbage can fall out during collection and creates a safety risk for our operators. In addition, loose garbage becomes wind blow debris when trying to empty the bin resulting in an untidy neighbourhood. **Bins containing unbagged garbage will not be emptied by District staff.**

# DID YOU KNOW?



Are you planning a Special Event on District Property? Did you know you need to notify the District?

If you are hosting an event on District property, such as a sports event, large gathering, wedding, festival, market, or similar—including locations like **Beattie Park, the Ball Fields, or one of our campgrounds**, you are required to submit a **Special Event Application Form** to our Recreation Officer.

This process ensures we can properly support your event and confirm all necessary documentation is in place, such as proof of insurance, food or gaming permits, and any required liquor licenses.

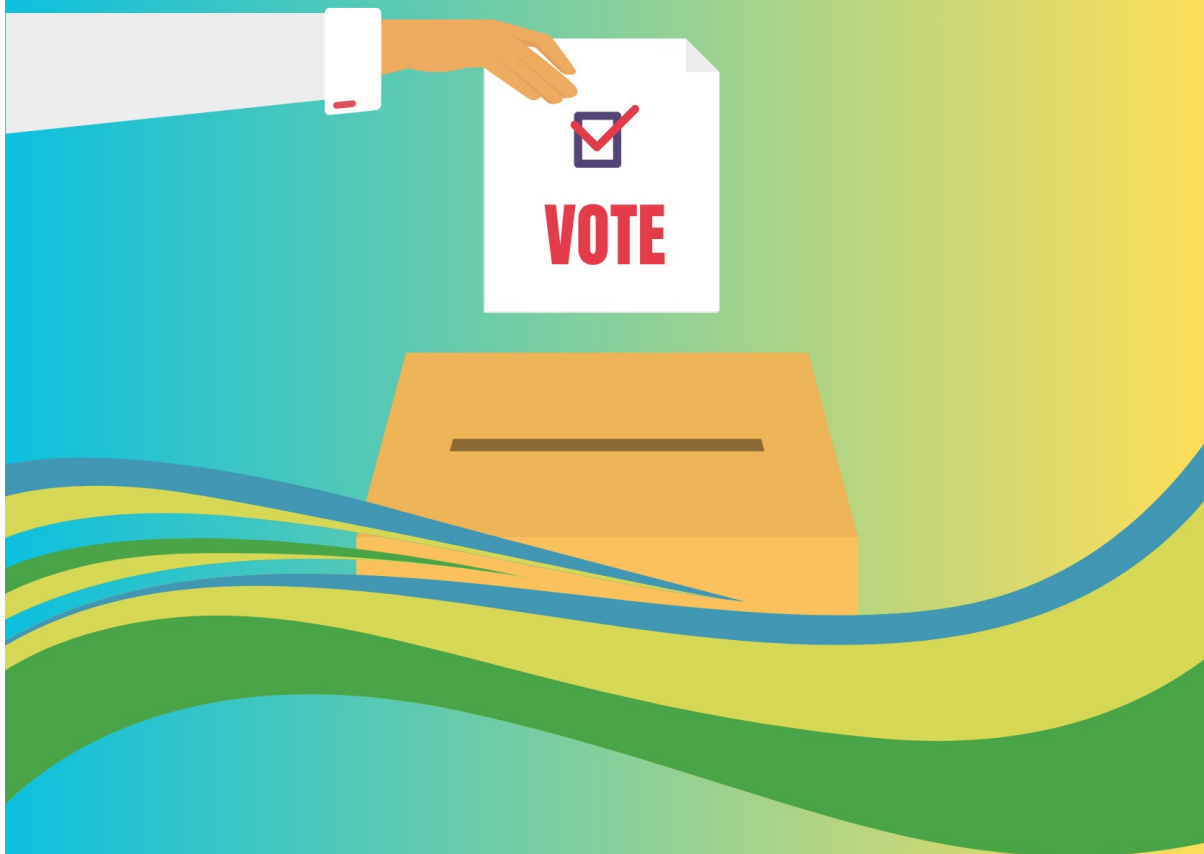

# Monthly Police Report



## Hudson's Hope RCMP Monthly Police Report

On June 5, Cpl Emilie Savard took over Detachment Commander duties of the Hudson's Hope RCMP. She is posted full time in Hudson's Hope and will soon become a familiar face in the community; however, we are still running one police officer short so you will continue to see out of town officers patrolling and responding to calls for the foreseeable future. Between May 20 to June 22, Hudson's Hope RCMP have responded to 33 calls for service.

Police received a report of a male loaning his PAL to another male to purchase a firearm. An officer retrieved the PAL and spoke with both parties, emphasizing that this was highly illegal. No firearm purchases were completed in this incident.

Two local residents were contacted by males identifying themselves as family members who had been arrested, one in Calgary and one in Fort St John. Though separate instances, both people were asked to withdraw large sums of money (+ \$6500) for bail. Both then received secondary phone calls; one from a "lawyer" and one from a "police sergeant." This is one example of the many types of scams attempted by low-life scam artists. Fortunately, these Hudson's Hope residents have been paying attention to the Police Bulletins, recognized the signs and did not fall prey.

Police received a complaint from Saulteau Security who are working at the Lynx Creek boat launch. A male launched his boat from that location, and left his truck and trailer parked there overnight. This area is designated for No Overnight Parking. Police contacted the male, advised him to remove his vehicle and warned him that in the future, it would be towed. Please pay attention to posted signage when leaving vehicles overnight.

A stolen work truck was recovered by employees via the GPS tracker. It had not been reported to police as being stolen several days prior. There was minor damage to the vehicle. There was dash camera footage of the thief driving the vehicle, however, the registered owner did not wish to pursue charges.

A brown 2019 Yamaha SxS was stolen during the night of June 5 from a location on Beryl Prairie Rd. Decals displaying "553" are displayed on both sides, above the rear wheels. Please contact police if you have any information on this theft.

Police received a report of a vehicle on Highway 29, near the Halfway bridge, that had

been involved in a collision with an animal. It was sitting on the roadway, partially blocking the lane. Queries of the licence plate showed that it was not registered to that specific vehicle (an offence). Queries of the VIN showed that it was not insured (also an offence). Police attended the residence of the registered owner. He stated he had noticed the vehicle missing from his rural property several days ago, but had not reported it stolen. He stated he had driven to FSJ earlier that day, in another vehicle, and saw his vehicle, crashed on the highway, and carried on with his day. Police advised him that they did not find this story credible and issued him a \$598 violation ticket for no insurance.

Several abandoned 911 calls were received during this month. Most were the result of faulty phone lines or power outages. One was a Crash Detection Alert caused when a motorbike rider dropped their phone while living their best life. A call was quickly made to police to advise what had happened and that there was no emergency. These alerts are common when phones are dropped, thrown, or fall off moving vehicles. They automatically dispatch BC Ambulance and RCMP. If this happens to you, please call us and let us know that there is no cause for concern. If a blocked number calls your phone, please answer and speak with our dispatchers to explain the situation.
