BYLAW NO. 629

A bylaw to amend Noise Regulation Bylaw No. 620, 2001.

WHEREAS under section 724 of the *Local Government Act*, the Council may, by bylaw, make different noise regulations and prohibitions for different areas of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Hudson's Hope, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Title:

1. This bylaw may be cited as Noise Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 629, 2002.

Exceptions:

2. Section 6 of Noise Regulation Bylaw No. 620, 2001 is amended by adding the following as subsection (k):
 - (k) the keeping or harbouring of any animal, poultry, or fowl for domestic purposes within a Rural Residential Suburban area pursuant to article 4.26 (g) of Zoning Bylaw No. 555, 1996.
