Online Course Requirements



Prior to submitting your application to the Fire Chief, you will be required to complete two online courses which make up components of the exterior firefighter qualification. Applications submitted without proof of completion of these two courses will not proceed further in the selection process. Both courses are available online at no cost. If an applicant does not have access to an internet enabled computer, then arrangements can be made to complete the required training at the downtown fire hall.

The Electrical Safety Course including both modules should take about 45 minutes. The ICS 100 course should take between 2 and 4 hours.

Electrical Safety Course

Once logged in click "My Training" on the left hand side

You must complete the Electrical Safety for Firefighters, Police and Paramedics **as well as** Electrical Safety Training for Firefighters.

Once each section is complete ensure you print off the certificates.
