

DISTRICT OF HUDSON'S HOPE

BYLAW NO. 621

A bylaw to amend the municipal ticket information system.

WHEREAS under section 272 (1)(a) of the *Local Government Act*, the Council may, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement; and

WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to amend the municipal ticket information system by including another bylaw for enforcement;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Hudson's Hope, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "Municipal Ticket Information System Amendment Bylaw No. 621, 2001".
2. Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw No. 590, 1999 is amended:
 - (a) in Schedule A by adding the following row to the table:

- (b) by adding the following table as Schedule B-2:

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3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedule B-2 to this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.
4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedule B-2 to this Bylaw are the fines set under section 272 (5) of the *Local Government Act* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
