



**DISTRICT OF HUDSON'S HOPE
BYLAW NO. 951, 2024**

A Bylaw to provide alternate means for publishing statutory public notices.

WHEREAS the *Local Government Act* and the *Community Charter* requires local governments to provide advanced Public Notice on certain matters of public interest to facilitate opportunity for public participation in local government decision making;

AND WHEREAS Council may adopt a Bylaw to provide alternative means of publishing Public Notice;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Hudson's Hope, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1 This Bylaw shall be cited as "District of Hudson's Hope Public Notice Bylaw No. 951, 2024".
- 1.2 District of Hudson's Hope Public Notice Bylaw No. 932, 2022, and its amendments are hereby repealed.
- 1.3 If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court, the invalid portion shall be severed, and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.
- 1.4 The headings used in this Bylaw are for convenience only and do not form part of this Bylaw and are not to be used in the interpretation of this Bylaw.
- 1.5 A reference in this bylaw to an enactment is a reference to an enactment of the Province of British Columbia and regulations thereto, as amended, revised, consolidated, or replaced from time to time.

DEFINITIONS

2.1 In this Bylaw,

"Corporate Officer" means the Corporate Officer of the District of Hudson's Hope;

"Council" means the Council of the District of Hudson's Hope;

“District” means the District of Hudson's Hope;

“Facebook Page” means the District's computer and internet-based technology information resource on the Facebook social media platform;

“Public Notice” means a notice that is required to be given or published in accordance with the *Community Charter*;

“Public Notice Posting Place” means the notice boards located at the District Office and the Post Office and the District's website;

“Public Service Announcement” means public notice by way of a user-subscribed email distribution list service provided by the District.

“Website” means the official internet website of the District whose uniform resource locator is www.hudsonshope.ca.

PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC NOTICE

3.1 When the District is required to give Public Notice, the Public Notice shall be provided as follows:

- a. By posting the Public Notice to the Public Notice Posting Place;
- b. By posting the Public Notice to the District's Website and District's Facebook Page; and
- c. By posting the Public Notice through the issuance of a Public Service Announcement.
