Interested persons can obtain information on the requirements and procedures for making nominations including nomination forms at the District of Hudson's Hope Municipal Office, 9904 Dudley Drive, Hudson's Hope, BC until the close of the nomination period during regular office hours of Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, excluding weekends and statutory holidays.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day February 24, 2024;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to, or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2024 local by-election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:
