



2024 District of Hudson's Hope Water Treatment Plant Loan Authorization Assent Vote

Notice of Closure of Advance Elector Registration & Inspection of the Electors List

An assent vote has been scheduled for Saturday, **October 5, 2024** to seek elector approval for authorization to borrow funds to finance the construction of a permanent Water Treatment Plant.

Are you eligible to vote? Is your name on the current list of electors? If you are unsure contact the District Office.

NOTICE OF CLOSURE OF ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Advance elector registrations can be completed at the District of Hudson's Hope Office, 9904 Dudley Drive, Hudson's Hope until **4:30 pm on Tuesday, August 13, 2024**. Advance registration will not be available after that date; voting day registration will still be available.

To register in advance, an elector must attend the District Office before the above deadline, to complete an application and provide 2 pieces of identification to prove both their residency and identification.

NOTICE OF PERIOD OF INSPECTION OF THE ELECTORS LIST

Beginning August 20, 2024 until the close of assent voting on October 5, 2024, a copy of the list of registered electors will be available for public inspection at the District Office, 9904 Dudley Drive, Hudson's Hope, BC from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays.

Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that they will not make copies or use the information included in the list except for the purposes described in Part 3 - Electors and Elections of the *Local Government Act*.

REQUEST TO OMIT OR OBSCURE

An elector may request that their address or other information about them be omitted from or obscured on the list of electors. The elector must contact the Chief Election Officer or the Deputy Election Officer to make this request.

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the Local Government Act until 4:00 pm on August 30, 2024. An objection must be in writing and an objection may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector for the District of Hudson's Hope and only on the basis that a person whose name appears on the list of electors has died or is not qualified to register as an elector of the District of Hudson's Hope.
